Ans. The places in the east get sunlight earlier than the places in the west because the earth rotates on its axis from west to east. Due to this the eastern part receives sunlight earlier than the western part.

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① Weather can be defined as the conditions of atmosphere at a particular time.	① Climate is the average condition of weather of a place or region in a longer time.
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② Weather can change many times in a day.	② Climate changes only after a longer time.
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5) What are the main factors which affect the climate of a place?

Ans. The main factors which affect the climate of a place are :- (1) distance from the equator (2) height above sea level. (3) distance from the sea and (4) the direction of winds.

6) What is 'Loo'?

Ans. 'Loo' is a very hot and dry wind which blows during the months of May/June.

7) What are the main characteristics of the climate of Congo?

Ans. The climate of Congo is hot and wet all the year around. The average temperature is about 27°C . The annual range of temperature is very low. Since it rains in the afternoons and at night there is more diurnal range of temperature.

8) Describe the wild life of Congo.

Ans. Congo is called the Natural zoo of the world. There are various types of poisonous insects, colourful birds and butterflies in these forests. The tree climbing animals like monkeys, baboon, gorillas, chimpanzees are found in these forests.
