Ans The Sun, the wind, the clouds and the rain these factors decide the weather.

Ans Solid liquid and gas. By heating water we can convert it into water vapour.

10) How are clouds formed?

Ans The heat of the sun changes the water in the seas, oceans, rivers, lakes, ponds and streams into water vapour through the process of evaporation. Higher up is cooler. When the water vapour comes in contact with this cold air it changes into tiny drops of water. These tiny drops of water cling together to form clouds.
